


The Engagement

The Project



- Non-functional requirements, such as quality, security, are actually functional requirements once you understand them as a integral part of your project.
- Important: how do you measure certain aspects of the project (non functional requirements, for instance).

The Project: Strategic Context

- The bank recently merged with another very large banking corporation, as a result, the following objectives are to be achieved:
- shorten and optimize front- and backoffice credit processes with an integrated and user-friendly system
- reduce paper work
- improve risk-management (e.g., incorporating risks in prices)
- improve sales hit rate
- cut cost, increase productivity











The Team:Communication & Coordination issues due to the division of labor

- n workers on a project
- $\square => (n_- n)/2$ interfaces (across which there may be communication)
- Potentially, almost as much as 2ⁿ teams which are to be coordinated
- Purpose of coordination: reduce the amount of communication
- Leads to:
 - **⊠**"Balanced Teams" with TECH + PROC experts
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 - **⊠Flat hierarchy**
 - **⊠It's supposed to be fun to work here!**
